### LAND FUND GIVING LOOKING GOOD

Contributions to our land fund to pay for the additional 140 acres in Dishman Hills Natural Area came to about \$1630 for the period Sept. 15 - Oct. 15, according to Treasurer David Lentos. Interest from our land fund is estimated at \$150 per month and recycling income, \$50 a month for a total of \$1830 a month. We need about \$2100 per month in order to meet our December payment of about \$6340. The difference, about \$270 per month, can be made up from our investment account. If donations continue at the present rate, we are on solid ground financially, thanks to you Dishman Hills boosters. Please keep the contributions coming--our thanks in advance.

If you have recyclables (newspaper, aluminum cans and foil, glass bottles and jars, junk mail and/or scrap metal) and can't haul them yourself, call us at 926-7949 and we will pick them up if the distance doesn't make the pickup cost more than the recyclables are worth.

We do not send receipts or acknowledgments for donations or dues unless they are requested. Membership renewals are due in January. These procedures simplify our bookkeeping and help hold expenses down. Thanks again!
